ICT: Information Communication Technology

A new phone system was installed throughout the school last week, ensuring all buildings are contactable and are on the same telephone system. We now have the ability to make group announcements to all learning spaces. Doing so, has strengthened our internal communication and our Work, Health and Safety practices and processes, in the rare event of an emergency.

Four laptops with Windows 10 are now in our Kindergarten room. Following on-site inspections by appropriate retailers and Regional ICT personnel, an Epsom Interactive Touch Projector and whiteboard bundle has now been ordered for our Kindergarten room. A date for the installation is yet to be determined. The cost of technology was an anticipated expense and within the school's budget. Extra data points and cabling issues in learning spaces will be addressed, as a result of a Regional inspection of our site. Extra cabling in a number of rooms will follow installation of our Interactive Whiteboard.

Teddy Bears' Picnic: this Friday 17TH March

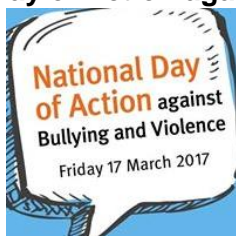
