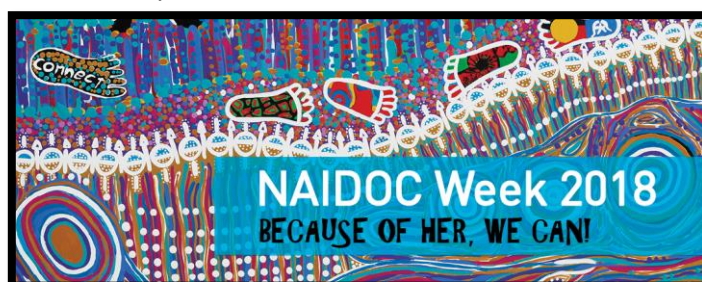
#### **Robokids Final session #6:** Tuesday 12 June
