NCCD

All schools participate annually in the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on school students with Disability (NCCD). This is consistent with the obligations of all schools under the *Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (DDA)* and the *Disability Standards for Education 2005 (the Standards)*. Schools draw upon evidence from a number of sources including accommodations and adjustments provided to students for at least a ten-week period, specialist reports and documentation of ongoing personalised learning needs. Preparation for the NCCD begins in first term, data is entered in term 2 and is finalised by the Principal in term 3.
