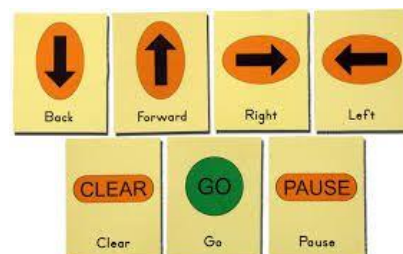
Dear Parents and or Caregivers,
