# School Audit

Last Tuesday and Wednesday the school engaged with an auditor from the Department of Education (DoE) reviewing a number of financial and health and safety areas.

# Home School Liasion Officer (HSLO)

Last Thursday I met with the Regional Home School Liasion Officer. For your information, please see the parental fact sheets attached to the newsletter, regarding school attendance and those which can be justified by the DoE. Please be advised you need to provide an explanation for student absences. If you are planning extended leave in Australia or overseas (over 5 days) please get a form from the office for Principal approval and a certificate of extended leave which is required for travel.

# Safety/security

The back gate will be locked at 9.20 each morning, once parents and caregivers have left the school grounds. It will be unlocked at 2.30 pm. The back gate is relocked after school. The vehicular gate will be closed when the teacher comes on duty at 9 am and remains closed, all day. The pedestrian gate is closed, but unlocked all day as it is the main entry gate for the school. I thank you for your cooperation in ensuring the pedestrian gate remains closed at all times to keep our students safe. *Please do not hook the gate open* even at the end of the day for the safety of staff who remain on site.

# Road safety

Please adhere to parking and speed restrictions in Crewe Lane for the safety of all. Parking rangers do monitor illegal parking and can, and do, issue penalties.

#### Students' birthday cakes

If you wish your child to celebrate his or her birthday, by bringing birthday cakes to share with other children in the class, we really appreciate small cupcakes. Some of our students, who have specific dietary requirements or allergic reactions, have their own cakes or treats in the staff fridge.

# Anaphylaxis/Allergic Reactions/Specific dietary requirements

Students at school are **not to share** food or drink with others for health reasons such as Anaphylaxis, Allergic reactions and/or specific dietary requirements. We ask therefore, that parents reinforce this message with your children when packing students' lunchboxes at home.

#### Medication

If you require the school to administer prescribed medication to your child for any reason we need **written** authority clearly stating the exact dosage and the times it needs to be administered. All medication is to be handed into the office in the morning in the appropriate container or package, clearly labelled, for the safety of all students.

#### **Voluntary School Contributions/ learning materials**

The school seeks for a voluntary School Contribution, which supplements funding given to us by the Government. It enables us to provide quality resources and materials for the educational benefit of your children. The *voluntary* contribution remains the same this year as last year, at \$40 per child.

#### Workbooks and Learning Materials

To cover the cost of workbooks and learning materials we seek \$70.00 each for Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 student. Please note that the workbooks do not attract GST. As always if any family is experiencing financial difficulty please do not hesitate to contact either the office or Mrs Fulham to discuss or inform, so that arrangements can be made.

#### Payments

- Money can be placed in the office in the K-2 container on any day. A receipt will be provided when it is receipted. If paying in cash, please place the **CORRECT** money in the provided **sealed envelope**, **clearly labelled** with the student's name class and purpose and deposit it in the K-2 container through the office window.
- The Department of Education provides a secure online payment system, through the Westpac bank called Parent Online Payment (POP) which is available to you through the school website <u>http://www.bardwelpki-p.schools.nsw.gov.au</u> Single or multiple payments may be made on the site and it is an easy method of payment.
- If you have any difficulty in paying for anything that we ask throughout the year, please see Mrs Maclean or Mrs Fulham know so that we can make other appropriate arrangements. Government schools support families who may be experiencing financial difficulties.

#### **Parent/teacher interview**

Please ring the office to make an appointment to see a teacher if at any time you have concerns regarding your child, so a suitable mutually agreeable time can be arranged. Classroom teachers do not read or respond to emails when on class.
